## Approval of Wake Stone Corporation Triangle Quarry Mining Permit Modification to Support Economic Growth, Quality of Life in the Triangle

The permit modification provides for the protection of Umstead State Park, while also unleashing the essential building blocks needed to support the region's growing local infrastructure needs. More than 90 percent of all Wake County aggregates are used within 20 miles of where they are produced. Thus, products from the expanded Wake Stone Triangle Quarry will be deployed locally in the Triangle, helping to build roads, bridges, schools, sidewalks, hospitals, homes and other critical infrastructure to support our quality of life and growing population.

"Wake Stone Corporation has been an excellent neighbor to Umstead State Park and we will continue to be a good neighbor as we begin the process of mining the property," said Bratton. "While there will likely be more litigation regarding the permit action, we are confident we will prevail in the court system and begin expansion and mining activities in the near future."
